***Feminist Review*, published by Palgrave Macmillan, has won the prestigious ALPSP Charlesworth Award for Learned Journals 2003.**

The award recognises outstanding journal design, including cover, layout and typography, with consideration for practical ease of use for readers and librarians.

When *Feminist Review* first appeared in 1979 it described itself as a socialist and feminist journal, 'a vehicle to unite research and theory with political practice, and contribute to the development of both'. More than 20 years later, and in a very different political landscape, *Feminist Review* remains committed to those core values.

For the 2002 Volume, a major and radical redesign of the journal, both internal and external, was implemented. The format was altered to enable a new, richer layout and typography. A new typeface was chosen – tarzana – which is individualistic and has attracted widespread praise from authors and readers.

The cover has also been significantly re-designed. It incorporates a new *Feminist Review* logo, the use of sharp colour and a bold, but simplistic graphic, which contrasts with the other elements of the cover. The result is a carefully struck balance between the identity of each individual issue and the overall brand of the publication.

Receiving the ALPSP Charlesworth Award for Learned Journals 2003 is a notable recognition of the success of the new look and feel - but also of the enduring relevance and quality of *Feminist Review*.
